Spring Community Cleanup Day

9 a.m. – 3 p.m.

**Where: Video Products Distributors (VPD),
4250 W Town Center Blvd, El Dorado Hills.** Signs placed around the community will direct traffic to the Cleanup Day site.

What: Disposal of large or bulky unwanted items, overflow green waste, and items that cannot be picked up with regular curbside service. No Household Hazardous Waste, tires, batteries, etc.

Cost*: Free to EDH residents and those living within the El Dorado Hills CSD franchise area. Donations of cash and checks will be accepted by Community Vision, Inc. and will be used for renovating the Deputy Jeff Mitchell Little League Field at Bertelsen Park in El Dorado Hills.

How: Upon arriving at the collection site, volunteers will direct motorists to material-specific bins (e-waste, gently used items, green waste, junk, metal, co-mingled recyclables, bicycles, etc.).

Spring Cleanup Day is Almost Here! Will You Be Ready on May 2?

It's almost time for another Spring Community Cleanup Day! Saturday, May 2, 2009, will be here before you know it. Save the date to bring your unwanted bulky household items to the Cleanup Day site from 9-3 at VPD, 4250 West Town Center Drive, El Dorado Hills, CA. This event is free* to residents living within the El Dorado Hills CSD boundaries. CHP may be on site to check resident status and driver licenses.

Start cleaning out your closets, garages, attics, basements, backyards, and side yards. Trim your hedges and trees, give up that old bar-be-cue (minus the propane tank), unfixable screen door, cracked spa, unsafe car seat, broken toys, rickety ladder, broken saw horse, leaky cooler, out-dated computer, and unused ping-pong table. If it's gently used, Snowline Hospice charity **may** take it to sell at the Placerville store. E-waste and electronics can be dropped off – working or not – and will be refurbished or repaired to sell at the Placerville Snowline Hospice Thrift Store. Snowline Hospice is also looking for useable building materials to resell.

Whatever does not get re-used or recycled will be hauled to the Material Recover Facility (MRF) by Waste Connections.

*Pride Industries will offer off-site shredding for \$5.00 per box. Fee is to cover secure storage and transportation from Community Cleanup Day site to shredding facility.

There will also be bins for tree trimmings and other green waste, mixed recyclables such as glass and plastic bottles, aluminum cans, pressboard, cardboard, newspaper, and other recyclable paper.

Household hazardous waste (HHW) will not be accepted at the Community Cleanup Day site, but will be accepted that day (and every 1st and 3rd Saturday) from 9-noon at the Fire Station on Bass Lake Road ***weather conditions permitting***. Check with the Station Chief that morning after 8am to assure the HHW collection facility is open. The Material Recovery Facility (MRF) in Diamond Springs is also open from 9-4 to accept HHW. Other non-accepted items:

Construction debris, rocks, stumps over 30" diameter, vehicle tires, motor oil, vehicle batteries, refrigerators and freezers will not be accepted at Community Cleanup Day. These items are accepted at El Dorado Disposal's MRF in Diamond Springs. Do you have your voucher? It's good for dropping off up to 4 cubic yards of self-hauled material for free at the MRF. One voucher is good for a weekday and the other is good for a weekend.
